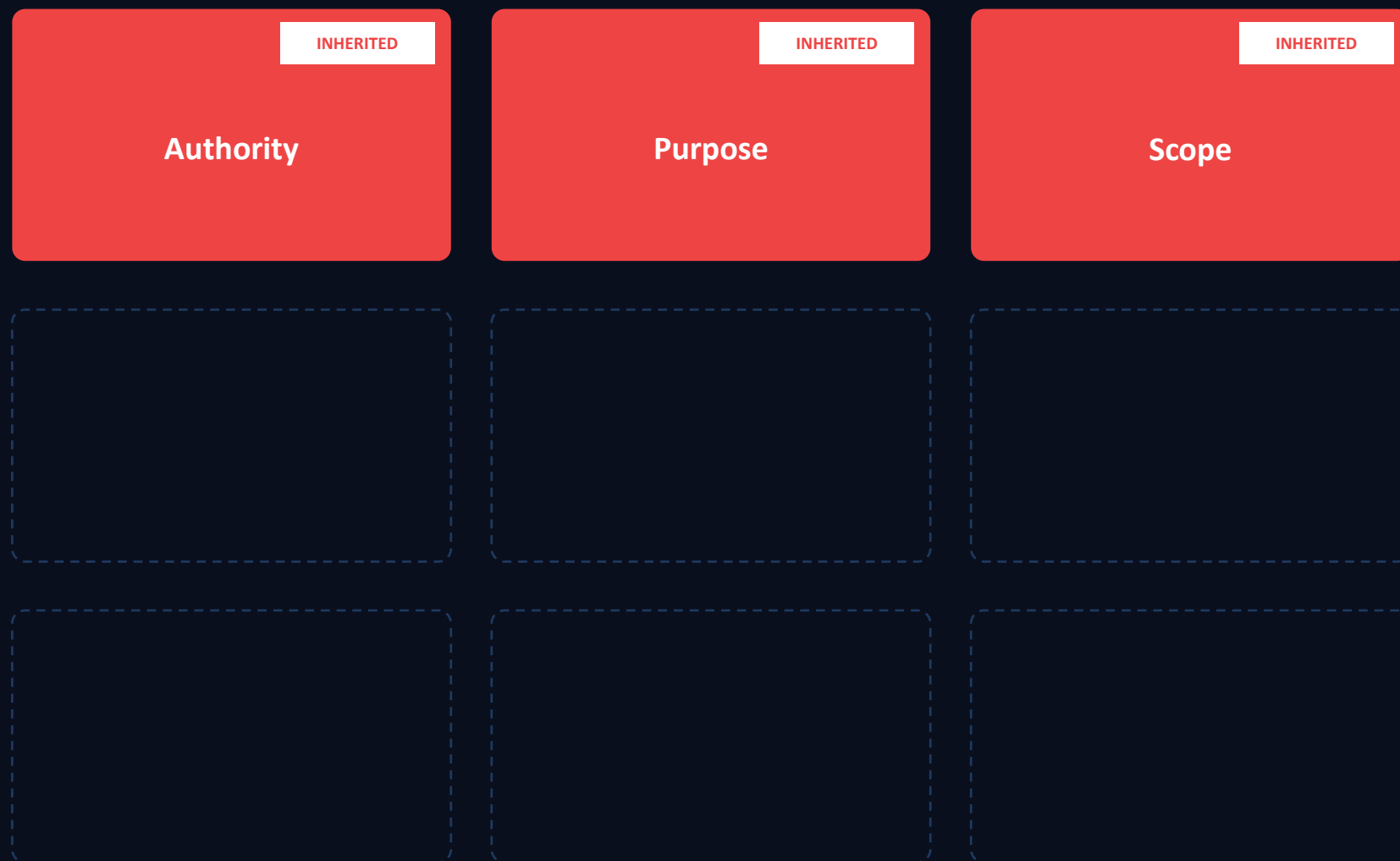

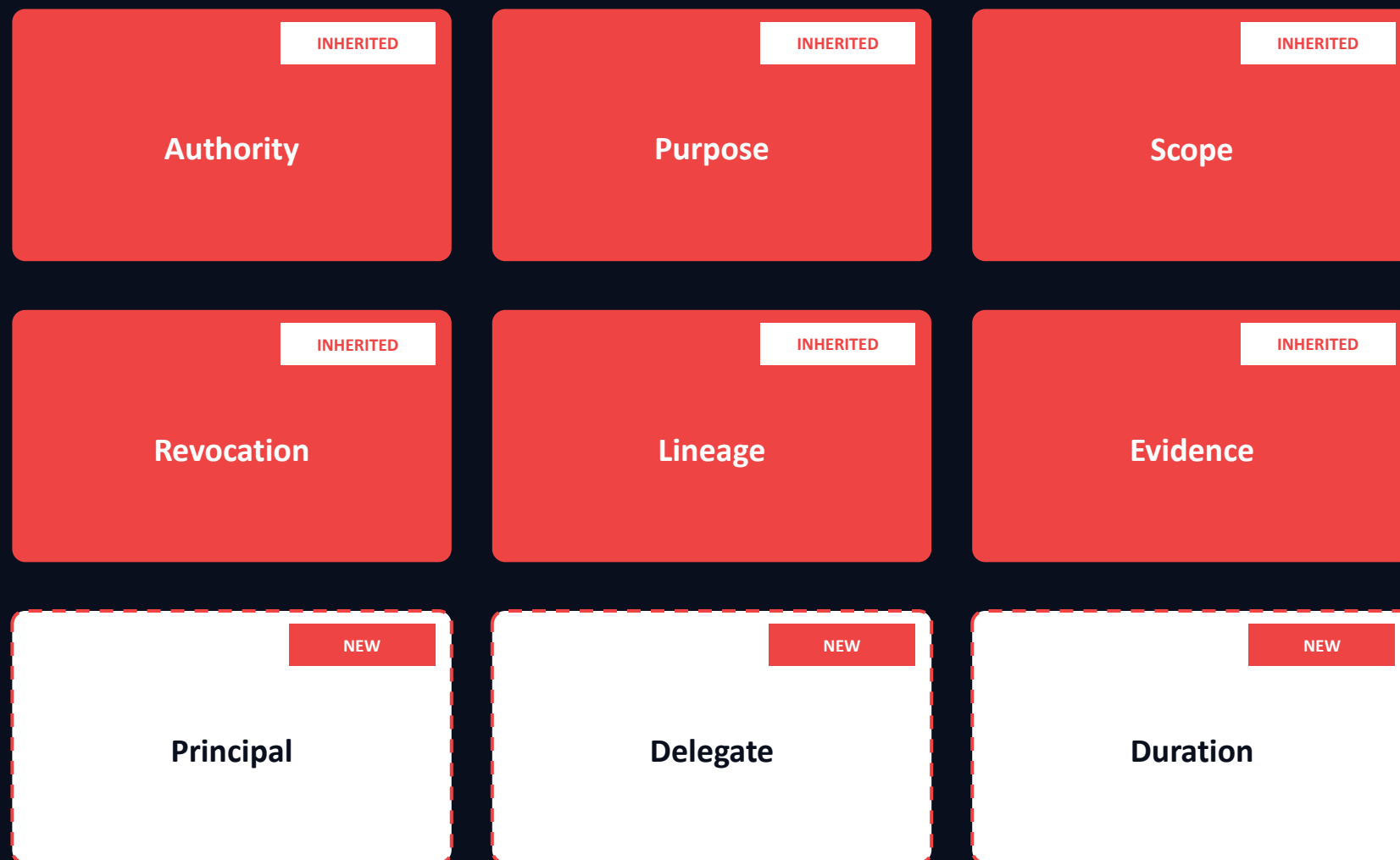

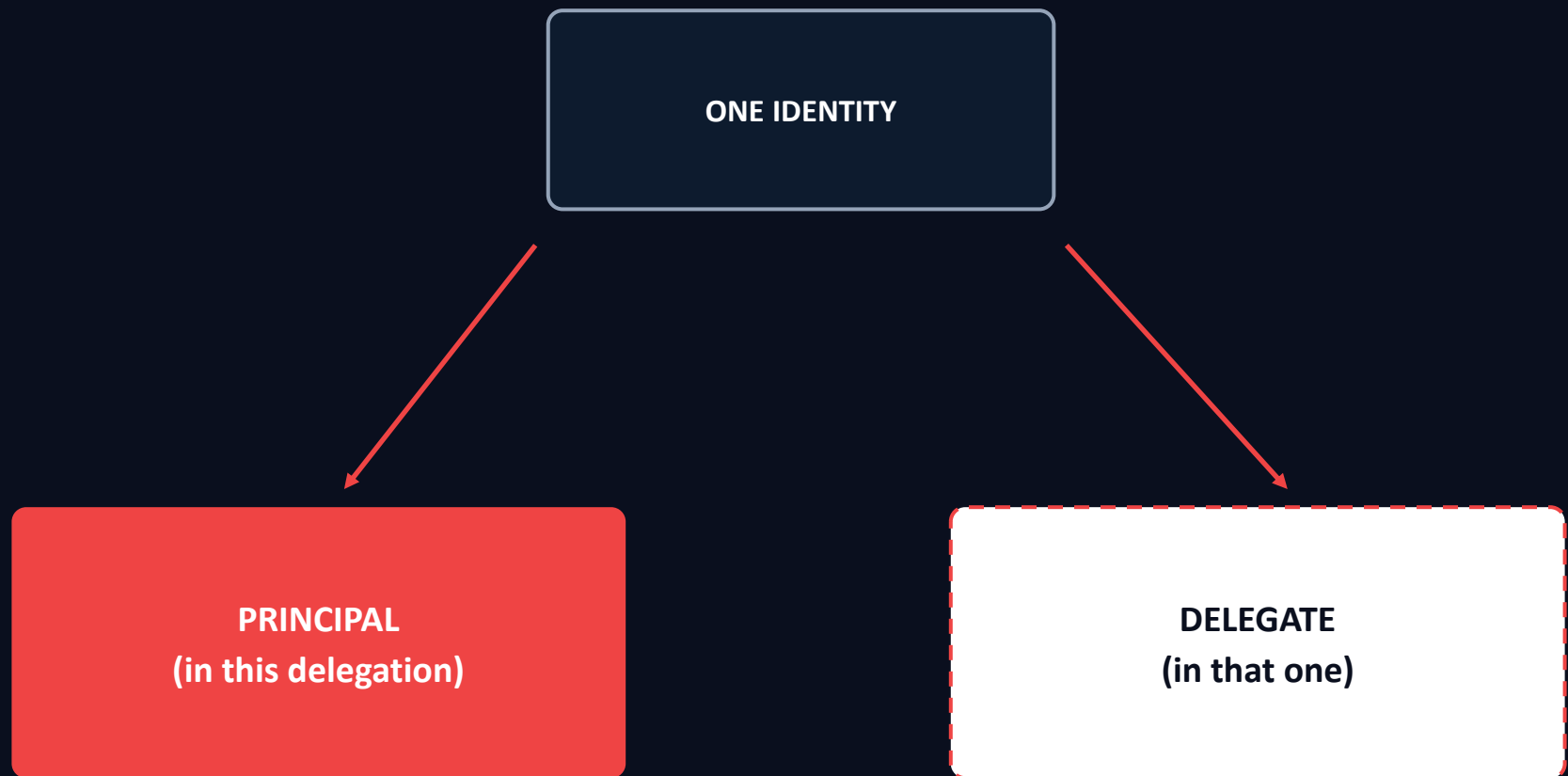
3 FIELDS ARE STILL MISSING

WHY IDENTITY ALONE CAN'T COVER THIS

PRINCIPAL $\neq$ DELEGATE $\neq$ IDENTITY
