Kubelet deprecated-flag removal — and the containerd CRI fallback tied to it — deferred from 1.37 to 1.38, explicitly to align with the end of containerd 1.7 support.

Confirmed independently: kubernetes.io container-runtimes docs state the fallback “will be dropped” in 1.38 — not 1.37.

Runtime validation cycles scheduled

containerd 1.7 extended support ends September 2026

SCOPE — GKE ONLY, KUBERNETES 1.30–1.32

This is a support-policy deadline, not a
Kubernetes enforcement deadline. Nothing in
1.37 or 1.38 forces a runtime version on this date.

>_ ARCHITECT'S VERDICT

CITATION IS NOT FIDELITY.

Verify the claim, not the reference.

Architecture teams don't fail because they lack information. They fail because they optimize around the wrong information.
